To showcase the Noosa Biosphere Reserve as an international leader in the conservation of biodiversity.</li> <li>3. To preserve, promote and respect the Noosa Biosphere Reserve’s unique cultural identity and heritage.</li> <li>4. To incubate emerging creative sectors, and pioneer local opportunities in the future-focused global demand for cultural content.</li> <li>5. To foster innovative cultural ventures which bridge the divide between art, environment, science and technology.</li> <li>6. To develop innovative methods of cultural documentation.</li> <li>7. To capitalise upon the opportunity to develop sustainable cultural ecotourism projects.</li> <li>8. To nurture human and environmental engagement and interaction through cultural projects.</li> <li>9. To advise all stakeholders on the cultural priorities of the region.</li> <li>10. To promote acceptance, equity and respect of cultural values and foster connected communities.</li> <li>11. To educate other Noosa Biosphere Boards on the relevance and importance of culture in our community.</li> </ol>
